

Survivor Crop Paint Can Swap

Join us for this fun and optional swap during Survivor Crop. I participated in a swap like this in June at CKU and it was one of the highlights of the event. I love the Paint Can I received.

Swap criteria:

- Alter a one gallon sized paint can in any theme you would like to do. I would suggest a few themes in keeping with Survivor Crop; Breast Cancer Awareness, a Jungle or Island Theme.
- The can, the lid and the handle must be decorated in some form.
- Inside the can you will need to put an item for each letter for "Survivor Crop."
- Give only new wrapped items, items that you have personally created or items that you would want to receive.
- Each participant needs to spend a minimum of \$20 and a maximum of \$30 for this swap.
- Place a letter to the person you will swap with inside your can explaining all the items, along with your name and email address that way you'll be able to keep in touch with your paint can buddy.

Here are some examples for the letter S.

S-stamp, string, stickers, sheets of paper, something shimmer, shiny-sketchbook, scraps, stitching, sewing, storage, silver, shaker box, shopping, silly, sassy, staples, strips, salty (chips), sand (beach theme), sandals, school themed, scissors, scrabble letters, Scrapbook anything, sand paper, sea theme, scouts.

Make sure all items fit either a scrapbooking or Breast Cancer Awareness theme or a theme applicable to anyone. There are many items and embellishments that fall into these categories- just have fun with it. This is your chance to be very creative. You will need a total of 12 items to be in the can.
